On-the-Job Training Grants

A new grant for employers seeking workers, On-the-Job Training offers the unique opportunity to offset initial training costs to fill skilled positions, while building

organizational productivity as the employee learns job requirements. Employers participating in the grant will be reimbursed for a portion of the wages of the OJT trainee while an employee goes through training.

Typically training lasts between 3-6 months and has a long-term goal of enhancing job retention, imparting transferable skills, and helping employees obtain advancement opportunities within the organization. Employers, OJT Trainees and the OJT position must be approved for training before any hiring or training begins.
