The high school performance composite also includes the banked Algebra I scores for all first-year ninth graders. Northwest also includes percentage of EOG and computer skills tests at achievement level 3 or 4 for grades 8 and grade 7 writing tests at achievement level 3 or 4 .
- (2) 2007-08 Focus School criteria based on percentage of FRL students only.
- (3) Expenditure data derived from Lawson Ledger (paid and encumbered) plus school activity fund expenditures. Funding sources for the expenditures include state, federal, county and other local. Child Nutrition, After School Enrichment Program (ASEP) and Capital expenditures are excluded.
- (4) Teacher FTE (Full Time Equivalent) derived from the state 6th month (December) pay period payroll file and includes regular and special instruction certified teachers from all funding sources.
- (5) Teacher average years of experience derived from the state 6th month (December) pay period payroll file.
- (6) Free and reduced lunch (FRL) demographic information is from the October 2007 applications and headcount calculation.
- (7) Ethnic demographic information is from the 20th day enrollment report.
